We usually switch classes depending on what subject we have but due to recent circumstances we stay in one class and teachers move from room to room.


Grading in our school goes from 5-1 with 5 being the highest grade and 1 the lowest. However, we all get a second chance to get a better grade if we failed the 1st time.

 Kids in Japan are the most independent of the lot. They travel to school alone, clean their own classrooms and even carry lunch.


There are no janitors or canteens in the schools.
